Directive vs Regulation
More uniform and harmonized rules
Beneficial for businesses operating in many MS

Strengthens existing rights
Introduces new rights
Particular attention to children

 - Data Protection by default and by design
- Data breach notification

- Abolishes notification and authorization system
- Document processing activities
- Data Protection Officer (DPO)

The GDPR – Attention to SMEs' needs

Reduced obligations with regard to:
Codes of contact
Certifications
Documentation of processing activities
Data Protection Officer (DPO)

The GDPR – Transparency Accountability and Self Regulation

Transparency – more information
Accountability – comply but demonstrate compliance
Self regulation – codes of contact, certifications, privacy seals
The role of professional associations and bodies

The GDPR – The role of DPAs

Strengthens their supervisory role
More investigative and corrective powers
Enhances cooperation
Joint enforcement operations in crossborder cases
Lead, competent and concerned DPAs

The GDPR – responsibility and liability

 More detailed provisions for controllers and processors

 Respective responsibilities for controllers and processors

In case of joint controllers, each is liable for entire damage

Dissuasive administrative fines

The GDPR – transfers to third countries
